Speedwatch still under manned and a call for more volunteers made. DH however was able to report that in the past month 165 vehicles have been targeted and 17 found to be speeding, fastest going at 47mph.• Young People & Families – Nothing to report.• Website – AS confirmed she has emailed all contributing groups requesting update of all info on the website. A meeting with TS will be forthcoming thereafter.• Broadband – BT have now reported that households on cabinet 8 may have to pay upwards of £800 to obtain superfast broadband.• Village Green - Nothing to report• St Marys School – Calor rural communities fund, Jubilee Hall Project. Our project is now available to vote for on the Calor website. You have to create an account to vote but this only takes a few minutes. Lime Class have enjoyed a music workshop. St Marys loves music festival raised £500 for school funds. Elder class have attended their levers service at Winchester Cathedral. The peer mentors completed their first pupil health and safety school check. They examined all areas of the school under the different health and safety aspects.
